### 2021 Term Dates

<b>Term One:</b>	Tuesday 2 February – Friday 16 April (Orientation day: Friday 29 January)
<b>Term Two:</b>	Monday 3 May – Friday 9 July (Orientation day: Monday 3 May)
<b>Term Three:</b>	Monday 26 July – Friday 1 October (Orientation day: Friday 23 July)
<b>Term Four:</b>	Monday 18 October – Friday 10 December (Year 11 to 13) or Wednesday 15 December (Year 7 to 10 to be confirmed)

### NOTES

- Homestay weeks are guidelines and may change with shorter or longer arrival and departure times.
- Student departures should be arranged for the first week after the end of term to avoid crossover with new student arrivals into homestays.
- Please avoid arrival flights on Orientation Days (Friday 29 January, and Friday 23 July), and morning departure flights because of ferry timetable.
- Students for Years 11-13 will not normally be accepted to start in Term 4.
