Term Four:	Monday 9 October – Friday 8 December	(final date for Years 11 – 13 tbc)

NOTES

- Homestay weeks are guidelines and may change with shorter or longer arrival and departure times.
- Student departures should be arranged for the first week after the end of term to avoid crossover with new student arrivals into homestays.
- **Please avoid arrival flights on Orientation Days (Friday 27 January and Friday 14 July) and morning departure flights because of ferry timetable.**
- Students for Years 11-13 will not normally be accepted to start in Term 4.
