

Code of Conduct

(Schedule One)

In line with Waiheke High School and community value, it is expected that all international students will:

General:

1. Comply with all the laws of New Zealand.
2. Comply with all school rules and all accommodation rules.
3. Not engage in any bullying or discrimination of any kind, including online.
4. Not consume any alcohol or illegal drugs or smoke or vape.
5. Respect other people (students, staff, and community), their opinions, and their property.
6. Complete all trip permission forms as required within the required timeframe.
7. Follow all instructions and rules of outsourced providers e.g. tour companies, instructors etc.

School:

1. Study to the best of their ability, completing class work and assessments as required.
2. Participate in sport and/or other school activities where possible.
3. Wear the school uniform correctly at school and to and from school.
4. Attend all scheduled classes and school activities unless sick.
5. Be on time for classes and arrive with correct equipment ready to learn.
6. Only use electronic devices in class for schoolwork with teacher's approval.
7. When appropriate, engage with online learning and attend online Google Meet or Zoom lessons, as instructed by the school.
8. Follow Waiheke High School and NZ Government rules regarding mobile phones at school.
9. Laptops/Chromebooks are used in most classes at Waiheke High School and students are required to bring a device to school each day that is sufficiently charged to use in all lessons.
10. Represent Waiheke High School with pride.

Accommodation and Outside of School:

1. Respect the privacy, property, and values of the homestay.
2. Be courteous, polite, helpful and considerate at all times.
3. At all times keep in communication with their homestay about their whereabouts.
4. Be an active member of the family and join in with family activities.
5. Abide by the rules of the homestay, including curfews.
6. Not own or drive a car or motorcycle or motor scooter.
7. Not be a passenger in a vehicle unless the driver has a full driver's licence.
8. All riders must operate bicycles, electric bikes, scooters, and electric scooters in strict accordance with New Zealand land transport regulations and the terms of their applicable insurance policy.
9. Not hitchhike.
10. Not gain any tattoos.
11. Not gain any piercings without prior permission of both the School and the Parents.
